Our Impact We serve more than **35,000** youth annually across **23** clubs across five counties in the Greater Houston area.

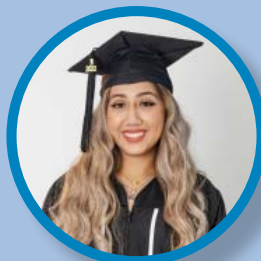
9 out of 10 youth are on grade level

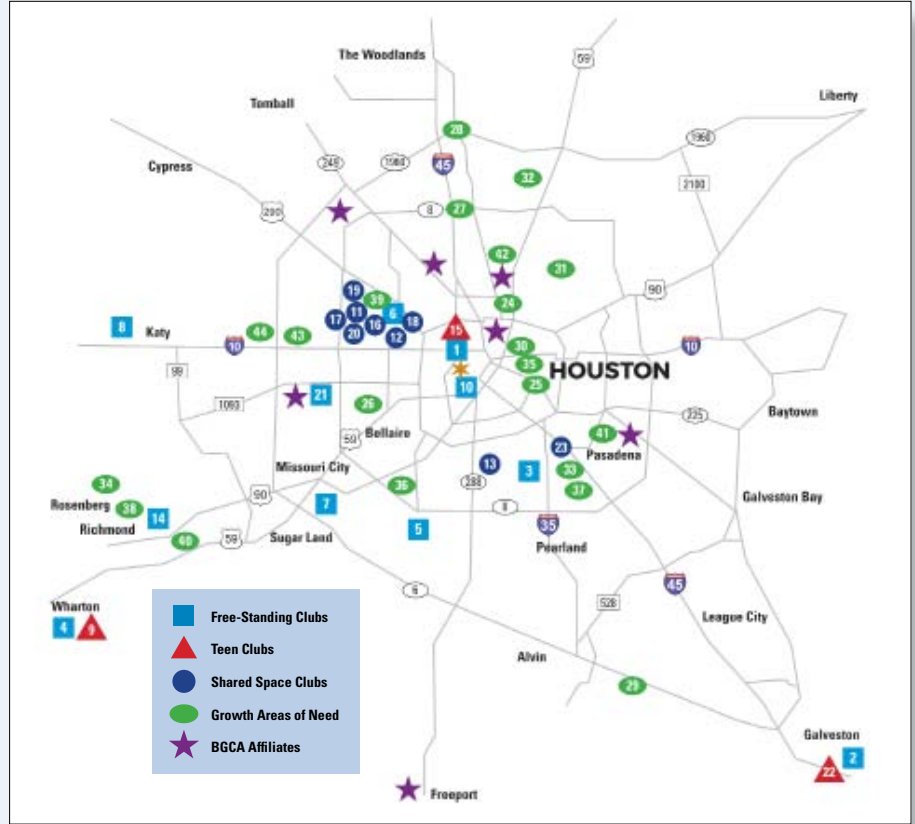
